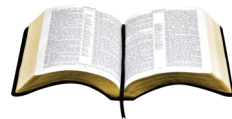
**Peace month.** A selection of poems by Thomas Merton on the theme of peace are on display in the church during this month. Come in and take some time to read, reflect, and pray.
